For this Christmas newsletter, we have selected the most recent ones published recently!

Forest LidaRioja (Spain)
The Forest-LidaRioja initiative was created with the aim of developing a forest inventory map and fuel model of the La Rioja region, in northern Spain, using remote sensing technologies.

Electronic Timber Tracking (Ukraine)
This system in Ukraine allows tracking the origin of timber and digitally represents the supply chain from the forest to the customer.

FeltGIS AS (Norway)
FeltGIS offers technical solutions for logistics of forest data. This digital solution provides an overview of production and storage with real-time data with a green router.

LegnOK (Italy)
LegnOk is a web portal aimed at providing registered operators with useful information on timber and wood derivatives exporting countries, together with a logical and guided pathway that allows risk analysis to be carried out.

LignoSilva (Slovakia)
LignoSilva focuses on the development of innovation with companies in the field of wood production, processing and utilisation and contributes to the enhancement of multipurpose forest management.
